## Keep Cool and Take Care...

Dangerously high temperatures and humidity produce higher and higher utility bills as we try to stay cool. About 45% of a utility bill goes toward heating and cooling the home. Some tips to lower costs and greenhouse gas emissions:

- \* Use a ceiling fan along with the air conditioner. Set the air conditioner thermostat 9° higher and save 30% on utilities.
- \* Keep coils on the exterior air conditioning unit free of dirt, grass clippings and leaves. Having central air tuned and the coils cleaned every 3 years saves 10-20% on energy costs.
- \* The "on" fan setting on a central air conditioner can circulate air continuously. This practice will usually even out the hot spots and will allow the thermostat to be set higher, saving money.
- \* Set air to highest comfortable setting during the day (78-80°), raising the temp by 1° can save 4-7% on the cooling portion of the energy bill. A change from 73° to 76° – 24 hours a day could save approximately 30% on summer cooling costs.
- \* Prune shrubs that may block airflow to air conditioner.
- \* Cook with microwave, barbecue, pressure cooker or crock pot or prepare cold meals to avoid heating up the kitchen and adding moisture to the air.
- \* Run dishwashers, washing machines and dryers during the evening hours (after 7:00 p.m.) when energy consumption is lower.
- \* Turn the fan off when you leave the room, as the fan does its job by cooling you, not the room.
- \* Use florescent bulbs. Turn off the lights when leaving a room. 90% of the energy from an incandescent bulb goes to heat.
