SAINT ANTHONY PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL MINUTES

The St. Anthony Parish Pastoral Council met on Monday, June 14, 2010. In attendance were: Diana Campbell, Jody Coaston, Margaret Del Favero, Ray Earls, Tina Eison-Jefferson, Jack Gillming, Kate Kenny, Roseann Klosterman, CSJ, Fr. Guest were newly elected members: Pat Fedders, Eric Frayer and Jesse LePage.



Increasing Engagement and Membership: Dave Trumpy – 1) New Council members will participate in the *StrengthFinders* program each September. 2) A new parishioner packet is finished and has been given to a few prospective new families. 3) An welcoming committee is being formed to begin in the fall. 4) A new Parish covenant was reviewed. Possible ways to share it with parishioners suggested by Council included: a) Print it on the back of the bulletin the Sunday our new council is installed and parishioners could be invited to make a personal and private commitment to it. b) Ministries could incorporate the covenant into their work. c) The worship committee could consider ways to incorporate it into the Liturgy periodically during the year.

Regional Parish’s Leadership Committee: Beth Scheid - A general overview was given for the benefit of the incoming Council members. Pastors, Pastoral Associates, Parish Council Chairs and Vice-chairs from Parishes of St. Anthony, St. Cecilia and St. Margaret-St. John meets quarterly primarily to provide updates on issues and events in their parishes. Key dates from the other parish events are published in our bulletin.

Focus Area Gathering Recommendation from Executive Committee: Beth Scheid - After the May 8th “renewal” meeting, they proposed Focus Area Gatherings be held twice during the year: **1) A Spring meeting between Parish Council and ministries** with the purpose to hear updates from each ministry on their progress to date, future plans and resource needs with a special focus on identifying opportunities across ministries. **2) A fall meeting geared to engaging the entire community.** The ministries will present their work in a fun, family setting and hope to enroll people as part of their efforts. This will be held after a Sunday Mass at 10:00 a.m. and will be coupled with a community pot luck social event. Stewards will continue to perform their roles in these gatherings. Council agreed to the proposal and an ad hoc committee was formed to help with this effort.

Pastoral Report: Fr. Dave - There has been a lot of response from the various advertisements used in the search for a new music coordinator. After the candidates are interviewed by the search committee, Wiley Howell and working with the choir and dance team, a decision will be made. August 1 will be Stephen’s last Mass with us. A farewell event to show our appreciation for his wonderful work at St. Anthony has been planned.

Sr. Roseann shared the 19 responses to a faith formation survey sent to parents in the spring. She reviewed the questions on the survey as well as the responses. After doing some more research with other parishes in the early fall, there will be some recommendations for changes that may occur in the faith formation program.

New Business: Beth Scheid asked for their input about what we consider to be St. Anthony main charisms. Photos of the new Council will be taken at the orientation meeting on Saturday morning, September 18.
